Sit egg on a cut down toilet roll. Draw and decorated the Egg to look like a person or, animal face, without any Hair.

Place somewhere sunny and leave to grow.


When grown, send the group a Photo!

Marble Boiled Eggs

Want to make hard boiled eggs for Easter that will really wow your **children**.




How to Make Hard Boiled Eggs that Look Like Marble

- 1. Choose the number of eggs you want to decorate and hard boil. Simply, place a pan on the hob and price some Water to the boil. Place eggs in the water and boil for 8 mins to ensure are hard boiled. This duration should ensure that they are hard and not runny. Allow to cool.
- 2. Next, you want to put cracks in each of the eggs. To do this, gently but firmly roll the egg on a hard flat surface until, the shell begins to crack. If you are not getting the results you want by rolling them, take a Spoon and lightly tap the outer shell until you have the cracks where you want them.
- 3. Place the eggs in the food colouring of your choice and let them sit for 10 minutes. Longer if you want a really vibrant colour.
- 4. Peel the eggs, and you should see a glossy, marble look on your eggs.
